

## **Weston Historic Landmarks Commission**

**Minutes for February 19, 2013, 6:00 p.m.**

### **Weston Memorial Hall**

- 1) Call to order 6:03 p.m. Present were: Wayne Wise, Ken Feekes, Bob Gilliland, Dawn Aby, Linda Crampton, Tim Crampton, Sheldon Delph, and guest Marthceltha Feekes.
- 2) Minutes of previous meeting read. Corrections of Member roster to be included, and Officers. Wayne moved, and Ken seconded to accept with corrections. Unanimously approved
- 3) Old business:
  - A) State Register to Local Register and Local Protected Status process: tabled to next meeting
  - B) Endangered Places grant; at beginning of application with HPLO, will continue with this grant and designation; due March 1. We can apply for multiple grants, but recommendation from HPLO is to choose one site, complete it in the 2013-2014 cycle, then move to next site. This will be Saling House for this cycle
  - C) Old Post Office and Blue Mountain issues continue
  - D) Clatsop Community College partnership for restoration program. This program will be making bricks this spring.
  - E) Oregon Heritage All-Star Community nomination is in progress
  - F) Signage grant update. \$5000 is available for use when we are ready.
  - G) CLG grants are due approximately February 22, 2012. Amount available is \$13,000. School planning for restoration is \$5,000, Saling House brick, door, and window work is \$5,000, City Hall for mold abatement is \$3,000 in grant application
- 4) New Business:
  - A) New National Register nominations: Weston Methodist Church and parsonage. We will provide expertise and support. We will need to formally approve the application as it is completed.

- B) Demolition permits and Archeology requirements. Ian Johnson from SHPO is assisting with these.
  - C) Preserving Oregon grant: recommendation to apply for this in conjunction with Endangered Places grant. The maximum award here is \$20,000. This will be for Saling House for this application cycle.
  - D) Preserving Oregon's Historic Cemeteries grant is due September, 2013
  - E) Clay body is still an issue for brick making.
- 5) Good of the Order. Donnie Bradley has contacted Tim regarding Weston and Proebstel family memorabilia.
- 6) Dismissal Tim moved, Wayne seconded to Dismiss at 7:00. Unanimously approved.
