 - 3a) Oregon Cultural Grant received for Wagon Site--\$5000
 - 3b) Preserving Oregon Grant Moved application to April 30th, 2014 for Saling House restoration; will be under Saling House 501(c)3
 - 3c) Methodist Church nomination update: Conference will continue work
- 4) Grants update
 - 4a) CLG grant City portion is underway, approximately \$5000 spent to date on electrical; Saling House will be completed by August 31, 2014; School \$5000 turned back to City to be used elsewhere in this cycle. City could use most, and Saling House could pick up balance. Moved by Bob Gilliland and seconded by Heidi Scott (Delph) to approve changes to CLG grant. Unanimously approved. The city portion becomes \$8000; with a 50/50 match. Wildhorse grant of \$7500 as match for city portion of CLG
