### Minutes

1c) Contractors are hired to work and so is a painter to do the detail work. This needs to be done by August 31, 2014.

1d) National Trust for Historic Preservation emergency planning grant for City Hall roof submitted; no response yet. There has been a response; no funds as of yet. Sheldon will touch bases were needed.

- 3) Rock and Brick retaining walls discussion for input to TGM committee. Which walls are salvageable?
- 4) The Bell is done and looks great, and is part of the CLG grant.
- 5) Reviews of Water Street Project (TGM) grant Scope of Work. Consultant will be here around the October 1, 2014

A motion was made to have Weston Historic Landmarks Commission to pay half for the Weston Commercial Historic District signs on Highway 11. This year they are \$500. They are paid every other year. The motion was made by Bob Gilliland and seconded by Wayne Wise. Unanimously approved.
