- 1) Call to Order 7:10 p.m. Present: Wayne Wise, Lyn Delph, Sheldon Delph, Bob Gilliland, visitor Vicki Bender
- 2) Review of State and local websites, Weston Leader and genealogy project at Library at 6 p.m.
- 3) Minutes of September 16, 2014 meeting read; 2 changes; 1e) should read "total", not "remainder", and Wayne Wise was present. Wayne moved, Lyn seconded to approve minutes as corrected. Unanimously approved.
- 4) Old Business
 - 4a) Oregon Cultural Grant received for Wagon Site--\$5000; Archeological and web research still need to be completed. Senior project possibility here.
 - 4b) Preserving Oregon Grant for Saling House restoration; will be under Saling House 501(c)3; completed 10/1/2014
 - 4c) Methodist Church nomination update: Conference continues work; Willamette University and University of Puget Sound Archivists are currently researching early history.
- 5) Grants update
 - 5a) CLG grant Bell wheel at School is part of grant and is underway, along with Saling House front door and roof and gutters work; completed, check is on its way.
 - 5b) Most Endangered Places (under Saling House 501(c)3, not City)

- 8) Walking tour update: QR code update; Senior project possibility here.
- 9) Rock and Brick retaining walls discussion for input to TGM committee. Which walls are salvageable?
- 10) Review of Water Street Project (TGM) grant; Next community meeting is week of November 12, 2014; each City Commission, plus numerous other stakeholders involved
