November minutes read. Wayne Wise moved to approve and Heidi Scott seconded. Unanimously approved.

No December meeting due to weather and roads

1. Old Business
 - 1a) Oregon Cultural rant received for Wagon Site--\$5000 (in process)
 - 1b) Preserving Oregon Grant for Saling House restoration; will be under Saling House. 501(c) 3.
 - 1c) National Trust for Historic Preservation emergency planning grant for City Hall roof submitted.
 - 1d) AWERE- \$40,000 for City Hall roof.
2. Walking tour update: QR code update; senior project possibility here. There are a couple of seniors interested in the project.
3. Rock and Brick retaining walls discussion for input to TGM committee. Which walls are salvageable?
4. The Bell is done and looks great. Mary Sams Tester wants to do the plaque for the bell.
5. CLG grant \$13,000 total with an additional \$13,000 local match; Application due by February 23, 2015. Planning for school site, school request \$5,000, local match \$5,000. CLG grant \$13,000 total (50/50 match). \$8,000 for City Hall, approximately \$16,000 to do windows, door, paint, heating, weatherization. Saling House included as a back-up project if all funds are not expended.
6. Review of Water Street Project (TGM) grant Scope of Work.
7. Water Street Project (TGM) grant; Next community meeting is January 28, 2015, 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. There was a lot of great information brought to us on ways to widen Main Street and Water Street for roadway and sidewalks.
8. Open commission positions: need attendance for the year, need for January, 2015 on who is up. There are three positions open. Need to go to Council meeting for approval.

10. Good of the Order: Cemetery book. List of all who is buried. The book is \$25. Lyn Delph made a motion to purchase the book and Wayne Wise seconded. Unanimously approved.
